A Level Spanish helps students develop confident, effective communication skills in Spanish and a thorough understanding of the culture of countries and communities where Spanish is spoken.

Entry Requirements

You must have a minimum of 5 grades 9-4 (equivalent to A*-C) at GCSE, including English and Maths at grade 4, plus you must also meet the specific subject entry requirements.

What will I learn?

On this course you will study a range of cultural, political and social topics and in doing so refine and extend your ability to read, write, speak and listen with accuracy and confidence.

How will I be assessed?

This course is designed to be taken over two years. In order to achieve this qualification, you must complete all assessments (oral, listening, reading, translation and writing) .

Where might it lead?

Spanish combines very well with a wide range of degrees but can also be studied on its own. Many students spend one of their years at university working in a Spanish speaking country gaining valuable work experience. Having good language skills greatly improves employability and life opportunities.
