## Quick Guide - Travel 2015/16

We are committed to supporting students to reduce their travel costs. This guide has some useful information about travel services to Strode's College, Egham. If you have any questions, please come to Student Services, we are be happy to help.

### CYCLING

Strode's College is committed to helping the environment and being green. We encourage everyone to use environmentally friendly ways of travelling to Strode's and provide free, secure bicycle racks for those who wish to cycle in.

### DRIVING

The College also has a car park with limited allocated spaces that can be purchased on a first come first served basis. Cars are £70 per year; Mopeds/Motorcycles are £30 per year. Please visit the Finance Department to purchase a pass.

### TRAIN SERVICES

The following train stations have links to Egham. Egham station is approximately five minutes walking distance from the College.

Weybridge, Addlestone, Chertsey, Virginia Water, Egham, Staines, Ashford, Feltham, Hounslow...*heading towards Waterloo*

Reading, Bracknell, Ascot, Sunningdale, Egham, Staines, Feltham, Whitton, Twickenham, Richmond...*heading towards Waterloo*

Guildford, Aldershot, Frimley, Camberley, Bagshot, Ascot ...*changing for Egham ... heading towards Waterloo*

Windsor, Datchet, Wraysbury, Staines...*changing for Egham... heading to Reading or Weybridge*

## BUS SERVICES

All bus stops in Egham are within five minutes walking distance from the College. Please refer to local operator information for timetables.

<b>71 Service</b>	First in Berkshire	To: Slough, Windsor, Old Windsor, Englefield Green, Egham, Pooley Green, Staines, Heathrow.
<b>441 Service</b>	Abellio Surrey	To: Heathrow, Stanwell, Ashford Hospital, Staines, Pooley Green, Egham, Englefield Green.
<b>500 Service</b>	Dicksons Travel	To: Frimley Park, Camberley, Bagshot, Lightwater, Windlesham, Sunningdale, Virginia Water, Egham, Staines.
<b>566 / 567 Service</b>	Abellio Surrey	To: Staines, Egham, Thorpe / Stroude and Virginia Water.
<b>656 Service</b>	Bear Buses	To: Sunbury, Upper Halliford, Shepperton, Laleham, Staines, Egham.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

<b>How can I reduce costs to my travel?</b>	Consider buying a young person's railcard for 30% discounts on off peak fares. Certain councils / boroughs offer discounted travel cards. Please enquire with your local office for more information.
<b>Should I buy returns or season passes?</b>	Season passes e.g. monthly or yearly travel cards are often cheaper. Please ask your ticket agent for advice.
<b>I drive, can I still save money?</b>	You could consider trying a car pool scheme where a group of friends share the driving.
<b>I travel from London, what should I do?</b>	You can apply for an Oyster 17/18 card that will give you free bus travel and child rate train / tube travel. It may be cheapest for you to split your travel between using an Oyster and an ordinary ticket. For example, using your Oyster card from London Zones to Feltham and then buying an ordinary ticket from Feltham to Egham.
<b>I am struggling with travel costs- can you help me?</b>	Yes, we may be able to help. Please come up to Student Services or email <a href="mailto:welfare@strodes.ac.uk">welfare@strodes.ac.uk</a> . We do have a travel bursary to help eligible students. For the 71 bus service, First in Berkshire offer a Scholar Ticket that gives young people in education discounted travel.

## FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR TRAVEL
